This data provides insight into the portion of the courses taught across full-time and part-time faculty pools by division. With additional data for the Spring and Summer terms, an expectation or standard will be set for appropriate full-time to part-time faculty proportions. Donna Swanson commented that the College has been and hopes will continue to be responsive in improving conditions for faculty that are facing a nationwide trend of low compensation and benefits.

3. Quality Initiative: Campus Rotation

President Winograd would like to build upon the strengths of many areas within the College that have incorporated a presence at all campuses. With this comes an expectation that all membership of President's Council begin making a concerted effort to rotate among all CNM campuses in a productive manner. 4. Discussion Topics:

a. Convocation Debrief

An appeal for comments and suggestions concerning the Convocation was received with positive remarks about building commitment and appreciation for the gathering. The event created new connections for many participants with more follow up contact from others. Suggestions included highlighting different groups for future convocations, holding a student convocation in conjunction with the College one, and the CNM minute follow up was great for continuing the energy.

b. Excellence Journey- Loi Carlson

Loi will be taking the group on a Journey of Excellence, which includes gathering all of the great things CNM does. Every two weeks, she will have a new "homework" assignment for the members of President's Council. This week Loi is seeking answers to the following two questions: "What are CNM's strategic advantages?" and "What are CNM's strategic challenges?" She will send the

questions by email with follow up at the next meeting for prioritizing the suggestions.

5. Rumor Control

The VPAA search is progressing with reformation of the steering committee due to some self selection of membership due leave the processes due to scheduling issues.

The Emeritus Academy will be reorganized into Organizational Learning to better align the type of work done within the Academic Affairs division.

6. General Discussion and Information Sharing

The Strategic Planning Forums will conclude this week with the last forum on Friday focused on faculty. The forums have been very productive with strong input from a wide-range of CNM constituents including faculty, staff, students, and community.

President Winograd has had several conversations with Representative Gail Chasey and Mayor Martin Chavez to create the opportunity for CNM students, faculty, and staff to utilize the Albuquerque bus system free of charge. Due to these negotiations, CNM anticipates covering the cost associated with this initiative beginning in January of 2008 with expectation of the Legislative appropriation given to UNM to be extended to CNM in the 2008 Legislative Session.

Hispanic Heritage Day was a success with over 300 attendees. Plans for next year include a Saturday event which is expected to create larger participation from the community.

ITS is planning a network upgrade which will need sustained down time for the network. This will effect all systems including distance learning, registration, and all access by faculty and staff. With further planning, ITS will work with President's Council to identify the best time in the near future for this upgrade.

Mental Health Awareness Week is next week at all four campuses.

Flu shots will be available next week for faculty and staff.
