Associate of Arts Degree in Fine Arts

Program Description

The Associate of Arts degree in Fine Arts provides experience and training in the areas of Art Studio and Art History and, for transfer purposes, covers the curriculum of the first two years of baccalaureate in Art study. It also serves as an end in itself. The degree includes a general education curriculum of 35 credit hours, which is accepted by New Mexico's colleges and universities as part of the general education core for degree completion.

The program includes both classroom and studio instruction.

Students wishing to concentrate their studies on the applied aspects of art should take classes in the sequence suggested on the Art Studio flowchart. Those wishing to concentrate on the history of art should take classes in the sequence suggested by the Art History flowchart.

Career and Advancement Opportunities

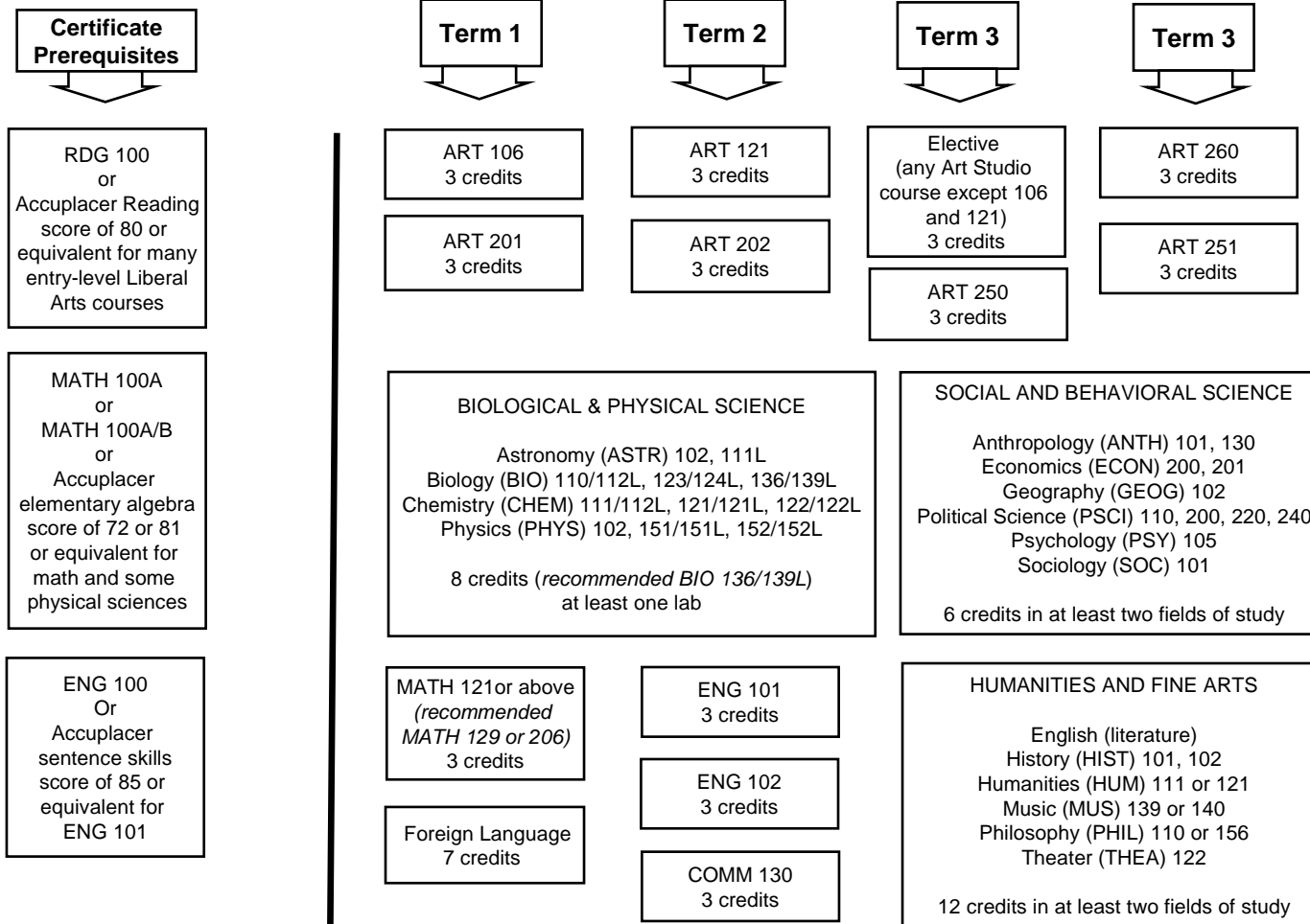
The course work in this degree will transfer to other institutions of higher learning.
