

Transfer Students

Do you have coursework at other institutions that qualifies as a prerequisite* for a course you want to take at CNM?

Best

Ask your institution to send us an official transcript. Or...

Bring an unofficial transcript (must include your name and the institution name) to Academic Advisement. You can print a web transcript in our Career Resource Center.

Here are the conditions under which you can be cleared in this office to take a course that has a prerequisite:

- If you have taken the prerequisite (and passed with a C or better) at a post-secondary institution with an established equivalency here at CNM.
- If you have taken (and passed with a C or better) a college-level course that assumes college-level reading, you can be cleared for an equivalent course (courses with a prereq of RDG 0950).
- If you have an Associate Degree or higher from an institution in the United States, you may take courses for which English 1101 and Reading 0950 are prerequisites.

If you do not meet the above conditions, but believe that you have the required prerequisite, contact the School office (at Main Campus) where your course is offered.
