College Level Examination Program (CLEP)

CLEP exams are administered up to 3 hours before closing (depending on length of test) Monday through Friday. For registration information contact any of our Assessment Centers: Main Campus SSC-204 (505) 224-3243; Montoya Campus TW-201 (505) 224-5761 or Westside Campus WS2 -113 (505) 224-5382.

CNM provides the College Level Examination Program (CLEP) only to students currently enrolled at CNM.

The exam is offered at the Main and Westside campuses only. The exam allows individuals who have acquired knowledge outside the usual educational setting to earn college credits. Credit is granted only to students enrolled at CNM and who achieve passing scores, as listed on the back of this sheet. **Only the exams listed on the back of this sheet are offered. No credit is granted for Subject Exams not listed.**

Registration: Students wanting to take a CLEP exam need to visit the Assessment Center to fill out registration form. Upon registration a receipt will be given for the non-refundable CNM **administrative fee of \$15.00** payable at the cashiers' office. The CLEP exam **fee is \$70.00 due** on the day of exam**. Credit card is the preferred method of payment-only American Express, MasterCard, and Visa accepted. Checks or Money orders made payable to CLEP are also accepted. **You must have a photo I.D. If you are repeating an exam you must wait six months. CLEP exams repeated within 6 months of the test date will have the scores cancelled and test fees forfeited.**

Please allow 15 to 30 minutes to process paper work and start exam.

Testing Rules

- Exams are 3 hours long with tutorials.
- **All examinees must present a photo I.D.** Acceptable types of photo identification include driver licenses, passports, and college-issued student identification cards. **Anyone who fails to present a photo I.D. will not be allowed to test.**
- Please do not bring any papers, beepers, or cellular phones the day you are testing.
- Scientific calculators are available on computer.
- Scheduled rest breaks will not be provided. If you must leave the testing rooms momentarily while the test is in process you will not be given extra time to complete the exam.

Test Results: CLEP scores are good for 20 years. You will receive a report of your scores approximately 15 minutes after completing the test. If you would like your exam cancelled, notify the administrator before submitting your exam for scoring. CLEP scores will be forwarded from Assessment Center to the CNM Records office and to the national CLEP offices.

Special Accommodations: Individuals with special needs who wish to take the CLEP examinations under special conditions are advised to contact the Assessment Center Lab staff: Main Campus SSC- 204 (505) 224-3251 and Westside Campus WS2-113 (505) 224-5446 to discuss their needs in advance of the test date. Examinees with Special Needs should allow 4 to 6 weeks for test materials to arrive prior to the test date if a special test version is required.
