SPANISH PLACEMENT EXAM

Spanish Placement exams are administered up to 1 hour before closing. The exam is administered by the Assessment Center: Main Campus SSC – 204 (505) 224-3243; Montoya Campus TW – 201 (505) 224-5761; and the Westside Campus WS2 -113 (505) 224-5382.

ABOUT THE EXAM - The Spanish exam is not timed and is free of charge. It consists of 100 multiple-choice questions. The Spanish placement exam determines what level of Spanish course you are ready to enroll in. ***This exam does not give you credit for any Spanish course.*** It is used strictly for placement purposes only. However, if the CNM catalog indicates any additional pre- or co- requisites, you must meet those before enrolling in a Spanish course. If you are interested in receiving credit for Spanish or any other foreign language course, please ask for information on CLEP exams.

TESTING RULES –

- Photo identification is required to take the exam.
- You must check in with the front office and receive a testing slip before entering the testing lab.
- Textbooks, notebooks, dictionaries, calculators, paper, children and/ or visitors are not allowed in the testing room. Anyone who gives or receives help during the test will not be allowed to continue the test and the instructor will be notified.
- Test materials and/or notes must not be removed from the lab.
- The Assessment Center may cancel test scores if there is reason to question the validity of the test scores.

TEST RESULTS - Once completed, the exam will be collected and scored. Your results will be available within 15 minutes of completion.

RETESTING – You may retest after 24 hours; however, you can only test twice within a twelve month period.
