- 2.** Take the Accuplacer assessment exam at any CNM campus (or get a copy of your ACT or SAT scores from the last five years).
- 3.** Register for courses online or at any CNM Admissions Office.  
  
Online at **cnm.edu** – Complete CNM's online new student orientation. Register online for course(s) using CNM's online registration system. Pay all course fees that are due by the following business day after registering.  
  
In person at any CNM **Admission Office** – Complete CNM's online new student orientation. Take your approval and registration form to any CNM registration office to register for your course(s). Pay all course fees that are due by the following business day after registering.
