

**Baking Program**  
**Required Dress, Tools and Equipment**

**TB Test**

You must obtain a tuberculosis (TB) test. This may be accomplished through your own physician or through the CNM Student Health Center at Main campus (900 University Blvd. SE). There is a \$10.00 fee at the Student Health Center. Verification of the results should be available on the first day of class to the instructor. The test is valid for one year.

**Uniforms**

- 2-double-breasted white chef's jackets
- 2-black and white checkered (hounds tooth design) chef's pants
- Shoes: 1-pair of all black with slip resistant soles. Tennis shoes or clogs without heel straps are not permitted.
- 2-white bib aprons
- 2-all white floppy chef's hats or all white skull caps
