4. Community College will select students for ADN and BSN tracks based on NMNEC selection criteria of 50% admission test, 40% GPA on selected courses, and 10% school dependent variables.

II. Services to be provided by designated parties

B. Admissions

4. i. All applicants must meet minimum NMNEC entry requirements. The application process is initiated at the community college.
- ii. Community College will select ADN students from the qualified applicant pool.
- iii. Community College will screen applicants for BSN NMNEC requirements and forward qualified student information, of those requesting the BSN track, to university for final selection to BSN track.
- iv. The University will select students for the BSN track based on NMNEC selection criteria of 50% admission test, 40% GPA on selected courses, and 10% school dependent variables for BSN selection.

- A. The term of this MOU will be for one full year from January 1, 2014 to December 31, 2014.
