Summary of Assessment Findings

Outcome 2: The mastery target was not met. From the 2016-2017 Annual Program Review Transfer Information (from data collected in 2017-2018) compiled by CNM’s Planning, Budget & Institutional Research department, 50% of the 2 students contacted who received the Associates of Arts in Career Technical stated that they were continuing their education.

Interpretation of Assessment Findings

Outcome 1 results will be reported in the AA General Education reports.

Outcome 2 results show that the target was not met with only 1 of the 2 students who graduated with their AA in Career Technical were continuing their education. There are still some concerns over the ability to obtain the transfer data. CNM is working with the 4-year institutions and the State of New Mexico to improve this process,
