

STEPS TO BECOMING A CNM BEGINNING FRESHMAN

1

APPLY AND GET A CNM STUDENT ID NUMBER

Go to cnm.edu/registration and click on Apply to CNM. Be sure to select “Beginning Freshman” as your student type. You will receive a CNM student ID number after applying or one will be emailed to you.

SET UP YOUR MYCNM STUDENT ACCOUNT

Go to my.cnm.edu or click on myCNM from the cnm.edu homepage.

APPLY FOR FINANCIAL AID AND SCHOLARSHIPS

Submit your Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.ed.gov. Apply for CNM scholarships at cnm.edu/scholarships. For information on how to receive the Bridge to Success Scholarship (a fall only scholarship), please visit cnm.edu/bridge.

COMPLETE NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Find out more at cnm.edu/nso. All Beginning Freshman students are required to attend in-person orientation.

MEET WITH A CNM ACADEMIC COACH

Visit cnm.edu/advisement and click on Schedule an Appointment. It is required that you meet with a CNM Academic Coach to discuss your course placement options. Be sure to bring your ACT or SAT scores, or complete the Accuplacer Placement Exam.

6

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Register for classes online through your myCNM student account.

7

PAY YOUR TUITION

Visit cnm.edu/cashiers for payment options and deadlines.

8

GET A CNM STUDENT ID CARD

Bring a state ID card, driver's license or high school ID to the CNM ID Office to get your CNM student ID card.

9

LOCATE YOUR CLASSES

Visit www.cnm.edu/maps-and-directory to locate the campus and building where your class(es) will be held.
