

STEPS TO BECOMING A CNM DUAL CREDIT STUDENT

1

APPLY AND GET A CNM STUDENT ID NUMBER

Go to cnm.edu/dualcredit and click on Apply as a Dual Credit Student. Be sure to select “Dual Credit” as your student type. You will receive a CNM student ID number after applying or one will be emailed to you.

2

SUBMIT THE REQUIRED AGREEMENT FORM

Visit cnm.edu/dcagreement. Turn in the required dual credit agreement form at any CNM Admissions Office within five business days after completing your application, or email it to admissions@cnm.edu.

SET UP YOUR MYCNM STUDENT ACCOUNT

Go to my.cnm.edu or click on myCNM from the cnm.edu homepage.

4

COMPLETE NEW STUDENT ORIENTATION

Find out more at cnm.edu/nso. Dual Credit students must complete the online orientation.

5

TAKE THE ACCUPLACER PLACEMENT EXAM

Go to cnm.edu/accuplacer and click on Schedule my Accuplacer. You must bring your CNM student ID number and a picture ID to take the exam.

6

MEET WITH A CNM DUAL CREDIT ACADEMIC COACH

Visit cnm.edu/advisement and click on Schedule an Appointment. It is recommended that you meet with a CNM Dual Credit Academic Coach to discuss your course placement options. Be sure to bring your ACT or SAT scores, or complete the Accuplacer Placement Exam.

REGISTER FOR CLASSES

Register for classes online through your myCNM student account.

8

GET A CNM STUDENT ID CARD

Bring a State ID card, Driver's License or high school ID to the CNM ID Office to get your CNM student ID card.

9

GET YOUR TEXTBOOKS

See your high school counselor for textbook instructions.

10

LOCATE YOUR CLASSES

Visit cnm.edu/maps-and-directory to locate the campus and building where your class(es) will be held.
