

How To Prevent Your Car From Being Stolen

1. Keep your vehicle locked at all times, even while driving.
2. When parked, never leave your keys in the car. Close all the windows and the sunroof.
3. Never leave your car running and unattended.
4. Avoid leaving valuables inside your vehicle where passersby can see them.
5. Do not leave your vehicle's title, registration and insurance information in the glove box.
6. Use an anti-theft device: steering-wheel lock, a hidden engine kill switch or a tracking device.
7. Park in a well-lit area when possible.
8. Have your car's vehicle identification number (VIN) etched on each of the windows.
9. If confronted by a carjacker, do not resist. Cars can be replaced; you can't.
