2. **Check-in time for workshops:** 8:30 A.M.
3. **Lunch:** Lunch will be provided for students. Please let us know of any food allergies.

5. **What to Wear:** Close-toed shoes (sneakers are fine) and appropriate attire are need to participate safely in the camp. No tank tops or crop tops are allowed.
