Effective August 1, 2019, Central New Mexico Community College (CNM) is in compliance with provisions for any student using U.S. Department of Veteran Affairs (VA) Post 9/11 (Chapter 33) or Vocational Rehabilitation & Employment (Chapter 31) educational benefits while payment to the institution is pending from VA.

The educational institution will not:

- Prevent the student’s enrollment;
- Assess a late penalty fee to the student;
- Require the student to secure alternative or additional funding;
- Deny the student access to any resources (access to classes, libraries, or other institutional facilities) available to other students who have satisfied their tuition and fee bills to the institution.

To qualify for this provision, the Veteran student may be required to:

- Produce the VA Certificate of Eligibility (COE) or Statement of Benefit no later than the first day of class;
- Provide additional information needed to properly certify the enrollment as described in other institutional policies;
- Provide a written request.

**This written request will be placed in the VA student’s file pending receipt of the required document.**
